**General Tournament Regulations**

1. The event will be run in accordance with ETTA tournament regulations.
2. Entrants must be Chinese in ethnicity, e.g. A parent or grandparent is Chinese.
3. Entrants for juniors are under 18 (after 1<sup>st</sup> January 1987) and for under 13 (after 1<sup>st</sup> January 1993).
4. The events will be drawn into groups. Two winners of each group will be decided. The winner of each group will be decided by a) matches won, b) games difference, c) points difference. All matches will be best of 5 games up to 11.
5. All losing players will be entered into the consolation event and will be required to umpire and should report to the control table immediately their match has finished.
6. Rackets. The surface of one side of the racket shall be bright red and the surface of the other side black, whether or not both sides are used for striking the ball in accordance with ITTF regulations.
7. Clothing worn shall be in accordance with ETTA tournament regulation 29 (Nothing white).
8. Competitors should report to the control table on arrival, at least 15 minutes before their first game and not leave the hall without obtaining permission from the referee or tournament director.

**General tournament Information**

1. The sports hall has a composition floor with Tungsten Halogen lighting.
2. Light snacks, water and refreshments and Chinese dinners are available at the venue.
3. Car parking facilities and changing rooms with showers are also available.
4. If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on the basis of last received first out.

**Directions**

**By Car from M1**

Leave the motorway at junction 34 (Sheffield Meadowhall). At the roundabout follow signs 'A6178 City Centre' and 'Attercliffe'.  
 Go past Meadowhall Shopping Centre on your right and continue straight ahead. Follow signs for 'Attercliffe' and 'Don Valley Stadium / Hallam FM Arena'.  
 Go past the Arena on your left and continue on Attercliffe Road. EIS-Sheffield is on the left (between ice Sheffield and Don Valley Stadium) on Coleridge Road.

**By Car from City Centre**

Travel through the Wicker and along Attercliffe Common towards Meadowhall. EIS-Sheffield is approximately 2 miles from the city centre on the right (after Don Valley Stadium).

**Parking**

EISS offers on-site parking. On major event days additional parking is available close by.

**Public Transport**

**Bus**

A large number of bus routes serve the Institute from the bus station / Sheffield Passenger Interchange and depart every 10 minutes. The route numbers include 69, 130, 287

**Supertram**

Sheffield's multi million pound light rail system has a stop close to the Institute. Trams connect to the facility from various points of Sheffield including the City Centre and Meadowhall, depart the tram at the 'Don Valley / Arena' stop.

**Train**

Sheffield train station is situated approximately 4 miles from the Institute. There are usually a number of 5-seater taxis available outside the station for you to complete your journey. (Average journey time from the train station to the Institute by taxi is 10 minutes; please note the journey time may increase during rush-hour traffic).
