Directions

By Car from South: Leave the motorway M42 at junction 7, take the M6 (N) exit to Birmingham (C & N). Merge onto M6. At junction 9, take the A461 exit to Wednesbury. At the roundabout, take the 1st exit onto A461/ Wood Green Rd heading to Wednesbury.

From North: Leave the motorway M6 at junction 9, take the A461 into Wednesbury, then take the 1st exit onto A461/Wood green Rd heading to Wednesbury.

Parking: The college offers on-site parking. On major event days additional parking is available close by.

Train: Bescot Stadium train station is situated approximately 4 miles from the Institute. There are usually a number of 5-seater taxis available outside the station for you to complete your journey. (Average journey time from the train station to the Institute by taxi is 10 minutes; please note the journey time may increase during rush-hour traffic)..

General Tournament Regulations

1. The event will be run in accordance with ETTA tournament regulations.
2. Entrants must be Chinese in ethnicity, e.g. A parent or grandparent is Chinese.
3. Entrants for juniors are under 18 (after 1st January 1991) and for under 13 (after 1st January 1996).
4. The events will be drawn into groups of six. Two winners of each group will be decided. The winner of each group will be decided by a) matches won, b) games difference,
c) points difference. All matches will be best of 5 games up to 11.

Veterans event will be a knockout competition unless we have time to group them.

5. The consolations, will be entered into a separate fixture and will be required to umpire and should report to the control table immediately their match has finished.
6. Rackets. The surface of one side of the racket shall be bright red and the surface of the other side black, whether or not both sides are used for striking the ball in accordance with ITTF regulations.
7. Clothing worn shall be in accordance with ETTA tournament regulation 29 (Nothing white).
8. Competitors should report to the control table on arrival, at least 15 minutes before their first game and not leave the hall without obtaining permission from the referee or tournament director.

General tournament Information

1. The sports hall has a composition floor with Tungsten Halogen lighting.
2. Light snacks, water and refreshments and Chinese dinners are available at the venue.
3. Car parking facilities and changing rooms with showers are also available.
4. If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on the basis of last received first out.
