General Tournament Regulations

- 1. The event will be run in accordance with ETTA tournament regulations.
- 2. Entrants must be Chinese in ethnicity, e.g. A parent or grandparent is Chinese.
- 3. Entrants for juniors are under 18 or have been born on or after 2nd January 1985.
- 4. The events will be drawn into groups. Two winners of each group will be decided. The winner of each group will be decided by a) matches won, b) games difference, c) points difference. All matches will be best of 5 games up to 11.
- 5. All losing players will be required to umpire and should report to the control table immediately their match has finished.
- 6. Rackets. The surface of one side of the racket shall be bright red and the surface of the other side black, whether or not both sides are used for striking the ball in accordance with ITTF regulations.
- 7. Clothing worn shall be in accordance with ETTA tournament regulation 29 (Nothing white).
- 8. Competitors should report to the control table on arrival, at least 15 minutes before their first game and not leave the hall without obtaining permission from the referee or tournament director.

General tournament Information

- 1. The sports hall has a composition floor with Tungsten Halogen lighting.
- 2. Light snacks, water and refreshments and Chinese dinners are available at the venue.
- 3. Car parking facilities and changing rooms with showers are also available.
- 4. If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on the basis of last received first out.

DIRECTIONS

By train: West Dulwich (5 minutes' walk). On the main line from Victoria to Beckenham Junction, Bromley and Orpington. Trains leave Victoria at 08 and 38 minutes past the hour, returning at 15 and 45 minutes past the hour.

Tulse Hill (15 minutes' walk). On the lines from London Bridge and Charing Cross to Sutton and Leatherhead, and to East Croydon, Purley, Caterham, Redhill etc.

North Dulwich (15 minutes' walk). On the line from London Bridge to East Croydon. Gipsy Hill (20 minutes' walk). On the line from Victoria, Battersea, Clapham, Wandsworth, Streatham Hill, to Crystal Palace, and East Croydon, and to Norwood Junction, West Croydon and Sutton.

By Bus: Bus routes Nos. 3, P4, P13 and 115 pass close to the College. Other routes within walking distance include nos. 2, 2b, 12, 37, 40, 63, 68, 78 and 227.

By Car: Entrance to the Sports centre is through College Road only. There is ample parking on the campus for visitors too.
