General Tournament Regulations

- 1. The event will be run in accordance with TTA tournament regulations.
- 2. Entrants open to everyone.
- 3. Entrants for juniors are under 17 (after 1st January2007) and for under 13 (after 1st January 2011).
- 4. The events will be drawn into groups. Two or three winners of each group will be decided. The winner of each group will be decided by a) matches won, b) games difference,
- c) points difference. All matches will be best of 5 games up to 11.
- 5. All over 40 players will be entered into a separate fixture and will be required to umpire and should report to the control table immediately their match has finished.
- 6. Rackets. The surface of the bat should be clearly of any two different colours, whether or not both sides are used for striking the ball in accordance with ITTF regulations.
- 7. Clothing worn shall be in accordance with TTA tournament regulation 29 (Nothing white).
- 8. Competitors should report to the control table on arrival, at least 15 minutes before their first game and not leave the hall without obtaining permission from the referee or tournament director.

General tournament Information

- 1. Light snacks, water and refreshments are available at the venue.
- 2. Car parking facilities are outside of the school gate and changing rooms also available.
- 3. If it is necessary to restrict entries this will be done on the basis of last received first out. Tick this box if you wish to receive information to play in the Chinese Table Tennis Championship.

Direction

. From North: Take M1 South, then enter M25 to East, then turn left into M11. From M11 turn right into A406, then into A12. From A12 continue to B119 then finally into Morpeth street. The centre is on the right side of the road.

From London: Since the tournament is on Sunday, it is best to take M25 South then into A2. Passing Greenwich to A102 then take A12 into Morpeth Street.

From London: There are other routes to take to get to Morpeth Street, driving through Central London, please use your satnay.

Parking: Please park outside of the gate. There is no parking restrictions on Sunday in Morpeth Street.

The nearest underground stations are Bethnal Green (Central Line) and Stepney Green (Hammmersmith or District Line)
